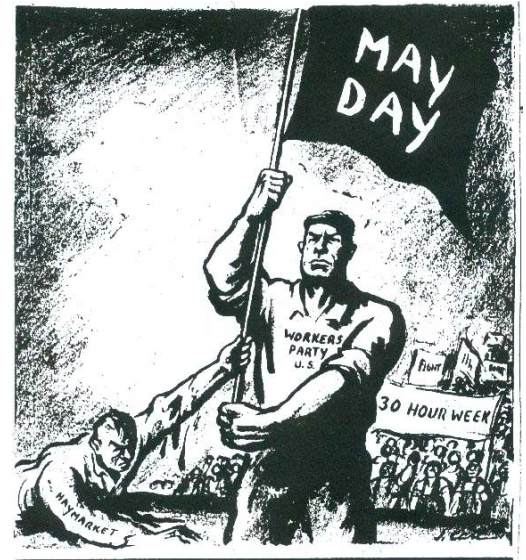


LABOR HISTORY TOUR #1
